

Terms of Use for Signing an E-petition

If you wish to sign an e-petition, you must accept the following Terms of Use:

- You must carefully read the guide entitled *Electronic Petitions — Guide for Signatories*, which is available on the e-petitions website.
- You must provide your full name, province or territory, country, postal code, phone number and email address.
- Your name will only be added to the e-petition once it has been validated by the Clerk of Petitions in accordance with the *Electronic Petitions — Guide for Signatories*.
- The use of false names or the provision of any information you know to be false is prohibited.
- You may only sign an e-petition once.
- The House of Commons reserves the right to remove your name from an e-petition at any time if it determines that these Terms of Use have been breached.
- None of the personal information you provide to the House of Commons will be published on this website.
- The House of Commons may use your personal information to contact you, validate your identity, ensure the integrity of the e-petition process and provide you with updates on the e-petition. Your personal information will not be shared or publicly disclosed, except in accordance with the *Electronic Petitions — Guide for Signatories* and these Terms of Use.
- A breach of these Terms of Use may amount to contempt of the House of Commons.

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
